At the end of the day, it is going to be clear that there are a lot of things that just don't seem fair. The truth is that most of life is like that. In those moments we have to decide how we are going to respond. There is a worldly response, and there is a Christian response. The Christian response is encapsulated in the words of Jesus, "whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also." (Matt. 5:39) and "Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God." (Rom. 12:19)

As in all things, Jesus is the example. When we are tempted to justify bad responses by saying things are not fair or how others should not have treated us as they did, we would do well to remember that the life of Jesus was rarely fair and people routinely treated Him in a way that He did not deserve. In spite of this He continued to love and even die for those very people. 1 Peter 2:23 speaks of the example of Jesus to us as an innocent sufferer saying of Jesus, "and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously."

His example should motivate us in our own relationships. Remembering what God has given, in spite of what is fair, can inspire us to give grace to those situations that are not fair. That is Christianity! **Go Seminoles! Go UGA!**
