

What Do They See?

In 2 Kings 20:14 Isaiah asks King Hezekiah about the visitors from a foreign land saying, "What did they see in your house?" Of course, this question is asked in a negative context, but I want to ask it from a positive context. What does your family see in your house? What do your co-workers see in your house. What does God see?

This last Sunday one of our prayers was a little lengthy, and I noticed that one of the children went out to the restroom. When they came back, we were still praying. The problem the child faced was that between them and their seat one of our men was deep in prayer with God, and he had no idea that there was someone wanting to pass by him. I watched that little boy as he patiently watched that older man praying. The child looked intrigued and just stared at this man who had his eyes closed, head bowed, and mind fully engaged on God. The child was watching him pray. In a world where so many struggle to pray, I thought what a powerful scene it was for that little boy to know what it looks like when a man prays.

This got me to thinking about what others might see when they look at me. Will they see someone engaged in understanding God's Word? Will they see someone singing praises out loud? Will they see someone bringing burdens before the Lord in prayer? If what my children know of being a godly husband and father is only what I have shown them, what have they seen? To be honest, through the years I have seen some pretty horrible examples, but I have also seen some wonderful examples. If someone comes up when I'm not paying attention to them at worship or through the week, I pray that they will see Jesus in me. "You are the light of the world." (Matt. 5:14)
